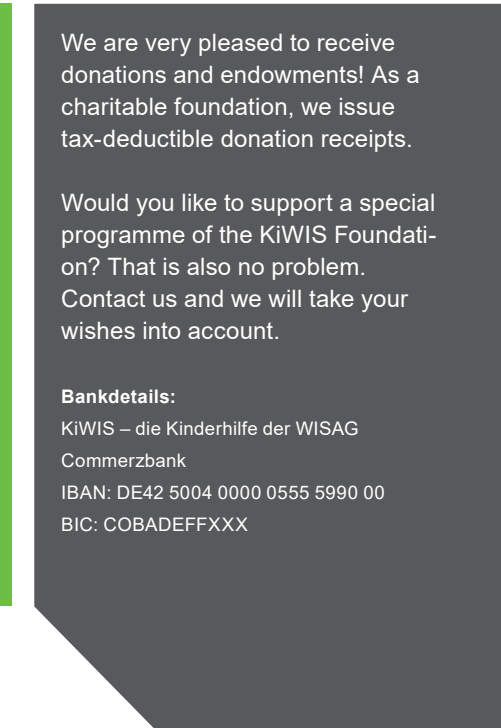

Strengthening educational opportunities for children and young people: That is the aim of KiWIS, the children's aid foundation of WISAG. We support children and young people in improving their performance at school, university and vocational training.

To this end, we have launched various programmes - from music sponsorships and scholarships to tutoring programmes. We promote the sporting, musical and scientific education and also focus on teaching a healthy diet with our own children's cookery courses.

We are convinced that a good future is possible with a good education - in the firm belief that you can make a difference and change things yourself if you never stop learning. As WISAG's children's charity, we want to lay the foundations for this and make our contribution to a colourful and well-functioning society. We are committed to creating more prospects for every child - encouraged and supported right from the start!

KiWIS Scholarship: Springboard

-  We award the **KiWIS school scholarship** for the best secondary school leaving certificate, secondary modern school leaving certificate and vocational school leaving certificate, as well as for the best A-levels, if the applicant is also committed to the WISAG core values.
-  The **KiWIS University Scholarship** is awarded by the foundation to enrolled students. Our scholarship holders have very good grades and are committed to the common good.
-  The **KiWIS training scholarship** helps young people who are unable to find a training place after leaving school.
-  Once a year, we honour the best trainee for outstanding performance with the **KiWIS Trainee Award**.

KiWIS Help: Supporting each other

-  **KiWIS Day-care centre funding**
Sometimes the start of family life is particularly difficult. If you are a single parent, the problems are often even greater. This is where we want to help: WISAG employees who are single parents receive support to **finance a U3 place** for their child if they can prove their need.
-  **Tutoring programme: Helping each other**
Struggling with Math (5) or German (5)? We offer assistance for academic challenges through tutoring. In line with the principle of „helping each other“, the KiWIS Foundation **sponsors tutoring sessions** for WISAG children, ideally provided by other WISAG children.
-  **Children's cookery courses**
We offer our own **children's cookery courses** for employees' children and grandchildren, where WISAG chefs enjoy teaching them how to cook, how to handle food properly and how to eat healthily.

KiWIS leisure care

-  **Study holidays at Tegernsee**
For schoolchildren from the 5th grade onwards, the foundation offers **week-long learning camps** during the school holidays at Lake Tegernsee. In addition to learning, the joy of leisure time in the midst of nature is also encouraged.
-  **Basketball camps on site**
Sport promotes children's performance and team spirit in many ways. KiWIS therefore pays the **fees for basketball camps**.
-  **Discovery days all over Germany**
We take your children to **exciting places of knowledge**. We explore modern museums and great child-friendly universities together and want to make the children curious about many scientific questions.
-  **Green days - the sustainable way**
Together with the gardeners and landscapers WISAG, the foundation organises child-friendly **action days** on the topics of environmental protection and nature conservation.
-  **Music makes you smart**
We promote the early musical education of children who learn an instrument by their 11th birthday learn an instrument or take part in **early musical participate**.
-  **Promotion of swimming courses**
Far too many children can't swim. We want to change that. That's why we **support swimming courses that lead to the seahorse qualification**.
